Literacy

- Try and complete daily phonics activities. This can be through games such as
 eye spy (using letters or sounds), active learn online (using log in provided in
 packs), reading their school book, complete a 'twinkl phonics mat' or online
 apps such as phonics play and alphablocks.
- Diary entry- Write a short paragraph about each day, using your neatest handwriting. Your diary entry could include who you've seen, what you have been up to or what films you've watched! After you have written your diary entry, read over it to check you've included capital letters, finger spaces and the correct punctuation.
- Pick 10 high frequency words from your pack provided. Try and write these
 in your cursive handwriting, put these words into a sentence and then take
 part in a spelling quiz at the end of the week and see how many you get right
- Complete Reading Paper 1 with somebody in your household. Ask and answer questions based on what has been read and even think of your own questions to ask the adults in your house just like mini teachers!
- The Alphabet Game- We really enjoy playing this game in Year 2! First, write the alphabet down the side of a piece of paper. Then each player has to think of a topic or subject. After that, see if you can write one down for each letter of the alphabet. For example, Animals- Ant, Butterfly, Camal, Dog etc.
