Nursery

Keep up the hard work Nursery! Myself and Miss Sharp have seen your wonderful work that you have sent to the school email address, and the work Purple-mash, and we can't believe how clever you are!

This weeks activities can repeated each day so that the children are familiar with the activities by the end of the week.

Literacy

- -continue practising name writing one letter at a time- make it more fun bu writing in sand, glitter, paint or gloop (cornflour mixed with water)
- -Listen to a different story each day- ask your child to describe the main character. What do they look like? Behave like?
- -Play a game- have a teddy, put the teddy on top, behind, next to, underneath and in front of a chair. Ask your child to say where the teddy is. Then reverse the game by asking your child to place the teddy underneath, behind, in front etc.

Numeracy

- -Continue to practise recognising numbers 1-10
- -Find three of the same object that are different lengths eg pencils, socks. Ask your child to put them in order shortest to longest. You could follow this up by playing the measurement activity on Purple mash-go into mini mash and click on the building blocks to find the measurement section.

Other

- -Purple mash/ mini mash activity -pairs game. Start with matching 4 cards and then move onto 8 cards.
- -Practise catching a large ball.
- -Watch Joe Wicks at 9am on youtube. Take part in some of the exercises- observe the affect on your body, heart rate, sweating, short of breath
