How are you doing? I hope you are all well and have been managing to get out for walks and a bit of exercise. At least the weather has been kind and we've had some lovely sunny, warm days to cheer us up a bit.

So, on with the business of home learning. Last week the government introduced the '**Oak National Academy**' to help children to continue to learn at home. Each week there will be a series of English, maths and history/ geography/ science lessons on the website. The lessons are taught via a video, by a teacher and are quite similar to what our lessons in class are like some of the time. Each lesson has a quiz to see if you've understood and remembered what you've learned. There is an English and maths lesson each day and one other lesson. I did last week's English lesson on Monday and I really enjoyed it. You can access the Oak National Academy from any device such as a phone/ tablet or computer and you don't need a login or password.

From this week, I'd like you to go on the Oak National Academy website and have a go at the daily lessons from Week 2 (that's this week). Click on **schedule** and then select **Year 4** from the menu. Don't forget, this is **optional** and you may still need an adult to help you with some of them. If you wanted to you could also go back to Week 1 and have a go at those as well.

BBC Bitesize have produced similar lessons and you might like to have a go at their home learning resources as well.

This week I've allocated more 2do's on **Purple Mash**. They are mostly to do with volcano's and there is some reading, writing and art type activities. I've also created a Year 4 notice board on Purple Mash, so if you'd like any of your work to appear on there just send it to the notice board and I'll put it on there. There is also a whole school 'Thank You NHS' notice board, so if you'd like to add to this get creating. I've already done mine and put it on there!

Reading - I can see that some of you have been having a go at the books that have been allocated to you on Bug Club, so well done and keep that up! There are some great books on there!

Keep using **Times Table Rock Stars** to practise the times tables. Remember, we need to know them all. Also have a go at the maths games on Purple Mash if you can.

PE - there are lots of links to physical activities in the 'Physical Activity Programme' on the home learning section of the school website.
