<u>Maths</u>

-Making a pattern with fingerprints. You could use paint or anything else with different colours, even tomato sauce and mayonnaise! Start a pattern for your child e.g. red, white, red, white. Ask your child to continue the pattern.

- Move on to doing this with two, then three objects.

<u>Literacy</u>

- Practise recognising letters s, a , t and what sound they make. Hunt around the house to see if you can find objects that start with one of the sounds.
- Find an old paintbrush etc and go outside with a bucket of water. Practise writing letters on the ground with a wet paintbrush. You could practise writing your name like this too!

Life skills

- Practise blowing nose if it is runny. If they don't have a runny nose you could show them how to find a tissue, wipe their nose and throw it away, then wash their hands.
- Practise washing hands and face when they wake up in the morning.
- Practise using a knife and fork independently.
- Play Simon says to identify and name body parts, e.g. Simon says point to your knee.
- Practise dressing themselves when they have had their morning wash.
- An extra bit of fun! We know you all love Space and the planets so much! See if you can spot planet Venus in the night sky. It looks like an extra bright star! Download an app like Starmap3D to find it!
