Literacy

- * Experiment with our voices and sounds, go to an outdoor space and see how close you need to be to your child for them to hear you whisper? Go under a subway pass or tunnel and experiment with echo's.
- * Sing simple nursery rhymes together.
- * Continue to practise writing your name, one letter at a time.
- * Talk about likes and dislikes with food, talk about flavours, textures, which foods are sweet, sour, spicy etc.

Numeracy

- * Continue practicing counting to 20 and beyond.
- * Collect outdoor objects from outside e.g. stones, sticks, feathers, leaves etc. and sort them into categories of colour, type or shape or order them by size.
- * Using your outdoor objects to do simple addition sums equalling to 5.
- * Practice writing numbers to 5

Other

- * Practice washing your hands, face and blowing their nose.
- * Encourage your child to dress and undress themselves (ready for PE sessions in reception)
- * Find out where food comes from using the internet.
