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Numeracy

- Ask an adult to hide some numbers- around the house. Search and find them. Remember to say the number and try to describe what numbers tell us.
- Look in cupboard for 3 different sized tins. Which is the heaviest, the lightest, the tallest, the shortest etc.
- Match all the socks up in the washing. Look for similar patterns that pair up.
- Look at some coins. Talk about their names, their colour, how many it is etc.

Literacy

- Sing some nursery rhymes together. Try to clap out a steady beat to the tune.
- Try to clap the syllables in the words below.

Other

- Put 5 or 6 small items on floor. Close your eyes while an adult takes one away. Can you remember the missing object?
- Help set up for dinner. How many knives, forks, plates do you need?
- Practise using scissors to cut pictures out newspaper or magazine.
- Play the What am i? game. Give clues and your child guesses the answer.
