Literacy

* Practise letter recognition by watching Alphablocks on YouTube. Complete a few alphabet activities on Mini Mash.

* Draw self-portraits using a mirror. Concentrate on showing your child how to do a circle for the face, drawing two eyes, a nose and a mouth, and some hair etc. Once the portrait is done the talk about similarities and differences between you and your child.

* Read a story a day together. Talk about specific parts of the story likes/dislikes etc. Try to use leading questions (questions without a yes or no answer)

* Sing simple nursery rhymes together.

*Continue to practise writing your name, one letter at a time.

Numeracy

*Continue practicing counting to 20

*Practice number recognition to 10 by watching number blocks on You Tube .

*Go on a shape hunt around the house, encourage your child to notice the shapes of everyday objects e.g. circle plate, square tv etc.

*Practice writing numbers to 5

Other

*Have a teddy bears picnic in the garden talk about the natural environment.

*Cosmic yoga

* Talk with your child about past significant events e.g. birthdays, days out etc. Encourage them to re tell you what happened this will help them to use talk to connect their own ideas.
