For the next 5 weeks I will be setting challenges for home learning linked to what we are doing in school that week. This week we are focusing on recapping previous skills that are really important to help us continue our learning.

Maths Recap

- Features of a clock, look at the numbers, hands, the minute and hour hand etc. If its o'clock the big hand needs to be n 12 and the hour hand points to the number.
- Recap numbers to 20 everyday- putting them in order, stating what is one more/ one less than a number and recognising them.
- 10x tables- counting in tens you can do this with objects also.
- Recap number formation- writing numbers correctly and the right way around.

Literacy extra ideas

- Phonics flash cards (in pack sent home)
- Read on the active learn website (links and usernames in packs) Please email me if you need new books allocating.
- Recapping writing your name (move on to surname if can write name with ease)
- Read and write tricky words- the, to, and, he, she, I, we, me, be, to, for
- Write a sentence about you're the things you like to do.
- Write a list of things you need for a picnic
 Can you put an adjective in your sentence such as big, shiny, round, scary etc.?
