This week have a look at division by sharing items equally between groups.

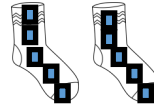
The division sign look like this... \div

When you are dividing a number you need to share it equally between groups.

So if you divide 10 items between 2 groups you have done the calculation $10 \div 2 =$

You could use 10 items and two socks to demonstrate this

Try these



$$8 \div 2 =$$

$$6 \div 3 =$$

$$12 \div 6 =$$

$$4 \div 4 =$$

$$20 \div 2 =$$

$$10 \div 2 =$$

$$50 \div 10 =$$

$$15 \div 5 =$$

$$100 \div 2 =$$

Have a look online for other simple strategies that you could use to divide the bigger numbers.

Keep working on times tables to help you with dividing.
