A little bit about Year 1

Year 1 will be slightly different for the class this year as there is a more structured approach. The children will be expected to complete more work but there will still be a practical element to a lot of lessons and an opportunity for children to continue their learning in continuous provision. As always our aim over the next few weeks is to help the children to adjust and settle in to their new class. The staff in our class this year are Mrs Jameson (Class Teacher), Mrs King (TA) and Mrs Hughes (TA).

Mrs Jameson (Class Teacher)

I have worked at the school now for 13 years and am one of the two Assistant Headteachers here at Moorside. I also lead the Early Years from Pod to Reception along with Key Stage One. Reading/ The Phonics Screening Check

Reading will be a huge emphasis again this year as the class will prepare for the statutory government Phonics Screening Check that will be administered in June 2022. Children will have the opportunity to read one to one throughout the week along with taking part in daily Phonics lessons, shared reading and guided reading. We ask that all children read at least 3 times per week at home. This will be hugely beneficial to your child's progress and will really help to prepare them for the Phonics Screening Check. If you need any support with reading at home, please just ask. We will have a weekly reading raffle and prizes for children that have read at home.

Spellings

Spellings will be sent out on a Friday and children will have a weekly spelling test the following Friday. This is non pressured and just helps children to embed the spelling of tricky words/ high frequency words etc.

Magic breakfast/ snack

All children in school receive a free breakfast each morning. They have the choice of bagels or cereal. The children will also be able to have a bagel at morning break time. All children in class will also receive a piece of fruit for a snack each afternoon.

School Lunches

All children in Key Stage One are entitled to a free school meal each day. The school menu includes two hot options and the choice of sandwiches or jacket potatoes. Children can still bring in a packed lunch if they wish to do so.

PE

This half term PE will be on a Monday afternoon and a Wednesday morning. Children can now come to school on PE days in sports clothes. We kindly ask that these are appropriate for sports both indoors and outdoors and that trainers or pumps are worn.

Toys

As we have many interesting and exciting toys in class already we ask that children do not bring toys in to school as this can cause issues and toys can get lost.

Uniform

We kindly ask that all uniform is labelled to help us ensure that children go home with the correct uniform each day. Children are responsible for looking after their own jumpers/ cardigans, however it makes it a lot easier to find when they are labelled. Please ask a member of staff if you would like us to label them.

Class Dojo

Many parents are now signed up to Dojo and this is the platform that you will be able to also contact me on other than in person or through phone call. I will upload class photos, messages and the weekly spelling tests on here. If you are not signed up and would like support in doing so, please just ask and I will gladly help with setting it up.
