<u>Reading:</u>

Year 3 will have the opportunity to read a range of genres. They will read information texts about Liverpool. They will also read newspaper articles that range from different years to see how sport has changed and has been documented over the years.

Writing:

The children will look into the history of Liverpool and Everton football clubs and use facts from this to write letters which persuade people to change their allegiance and support either of these clubs.

Children will learn about the history of the Liver birds and will create a narrative piece of writing over a series of weeks using the liver birds as characters in their writing.
