Writing:

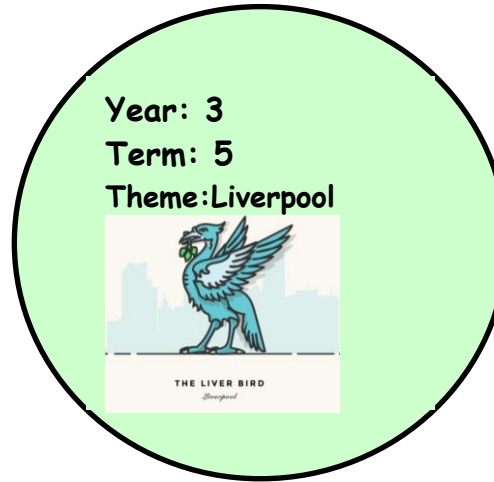
